Google Chrome Notifications & Pop-ups Tutorial

Purpose: Google Chrome displays pop-up notifications and settings can be updated to allow and remove certain notifications.

Step 1: Click the three dots top right corner (chrome) then click settings.

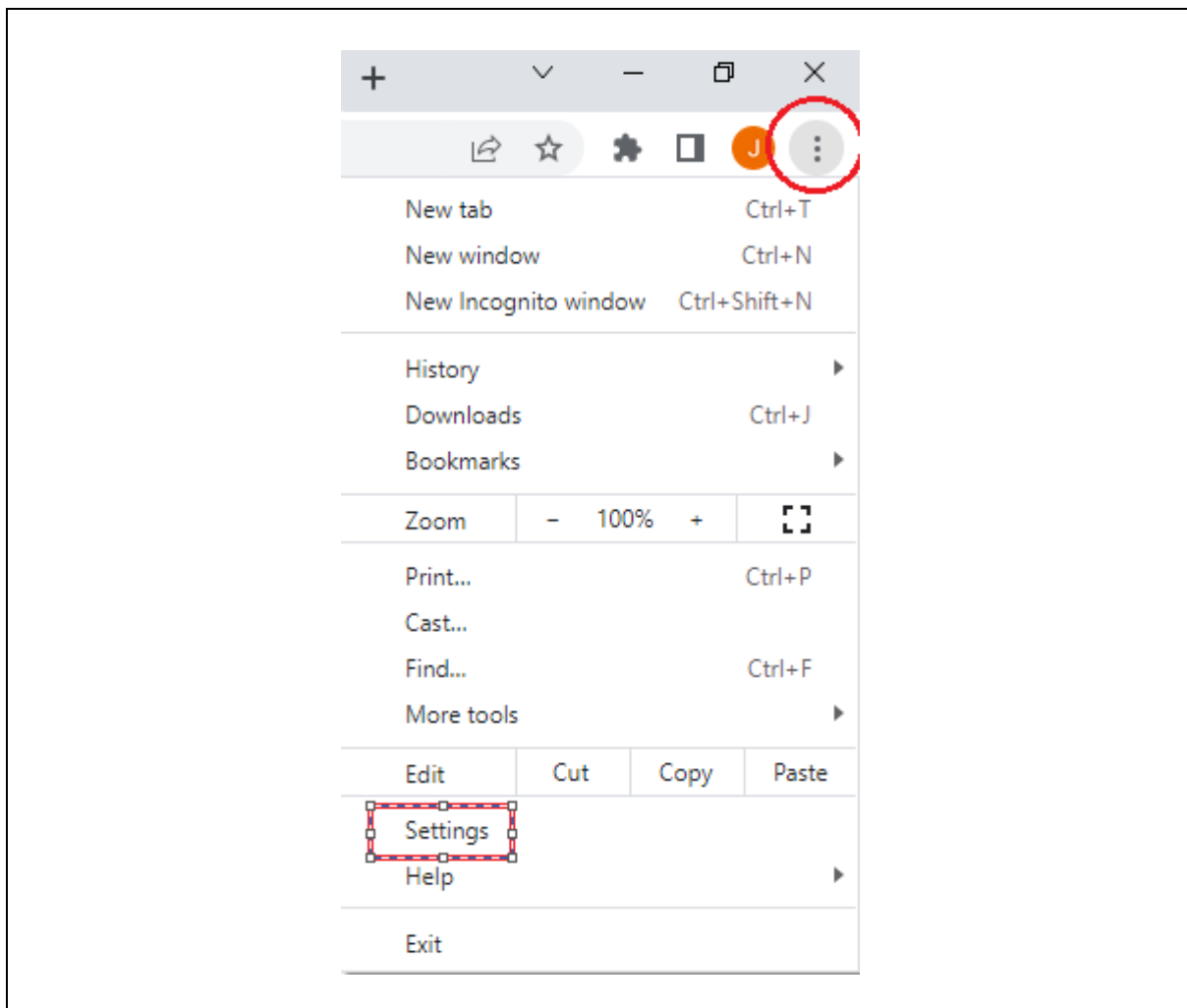

Step 2: At the top search: notifications then click site settings (will highlight with yellow arrow).

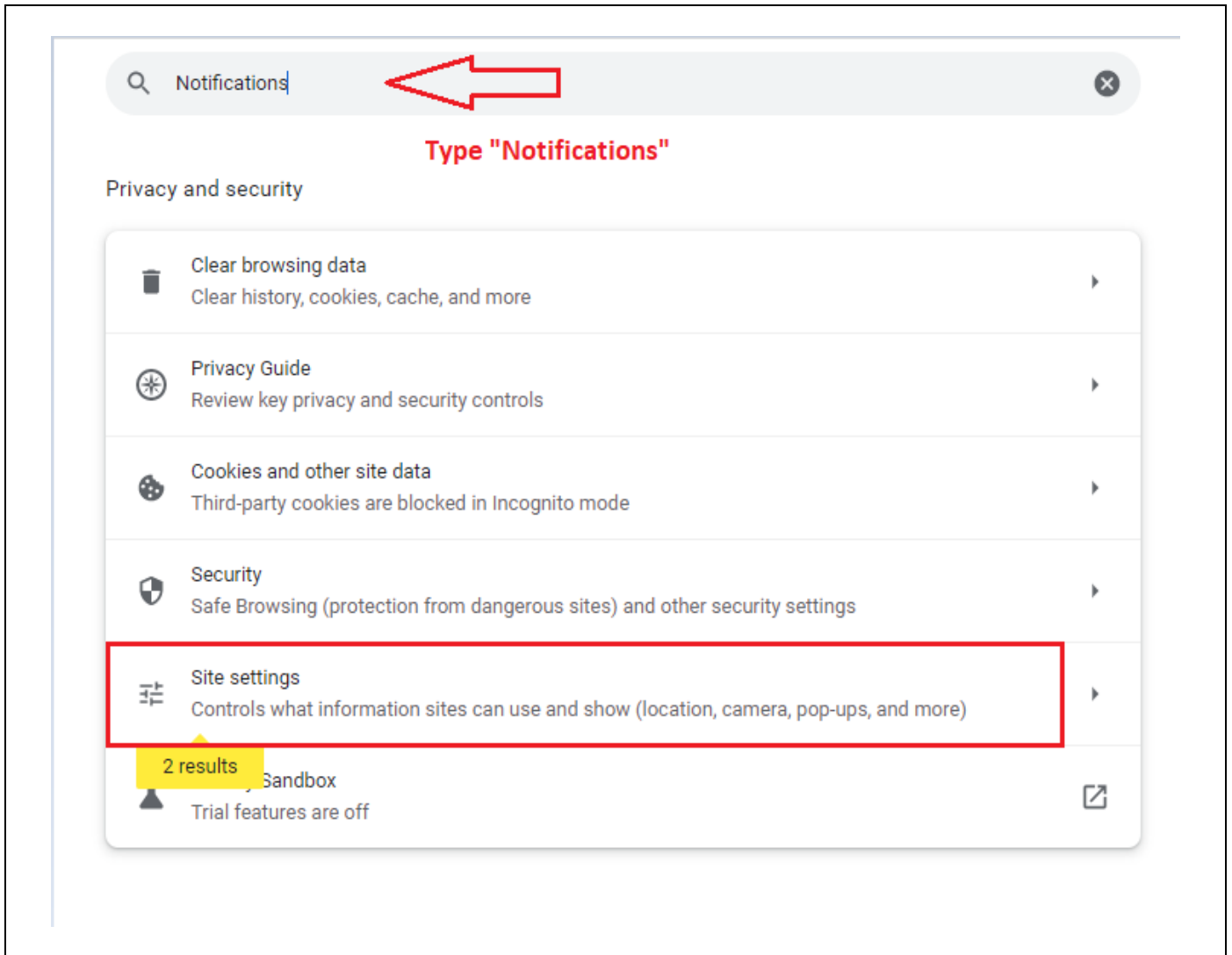

Step 3: Click notifications (yellow arrow).

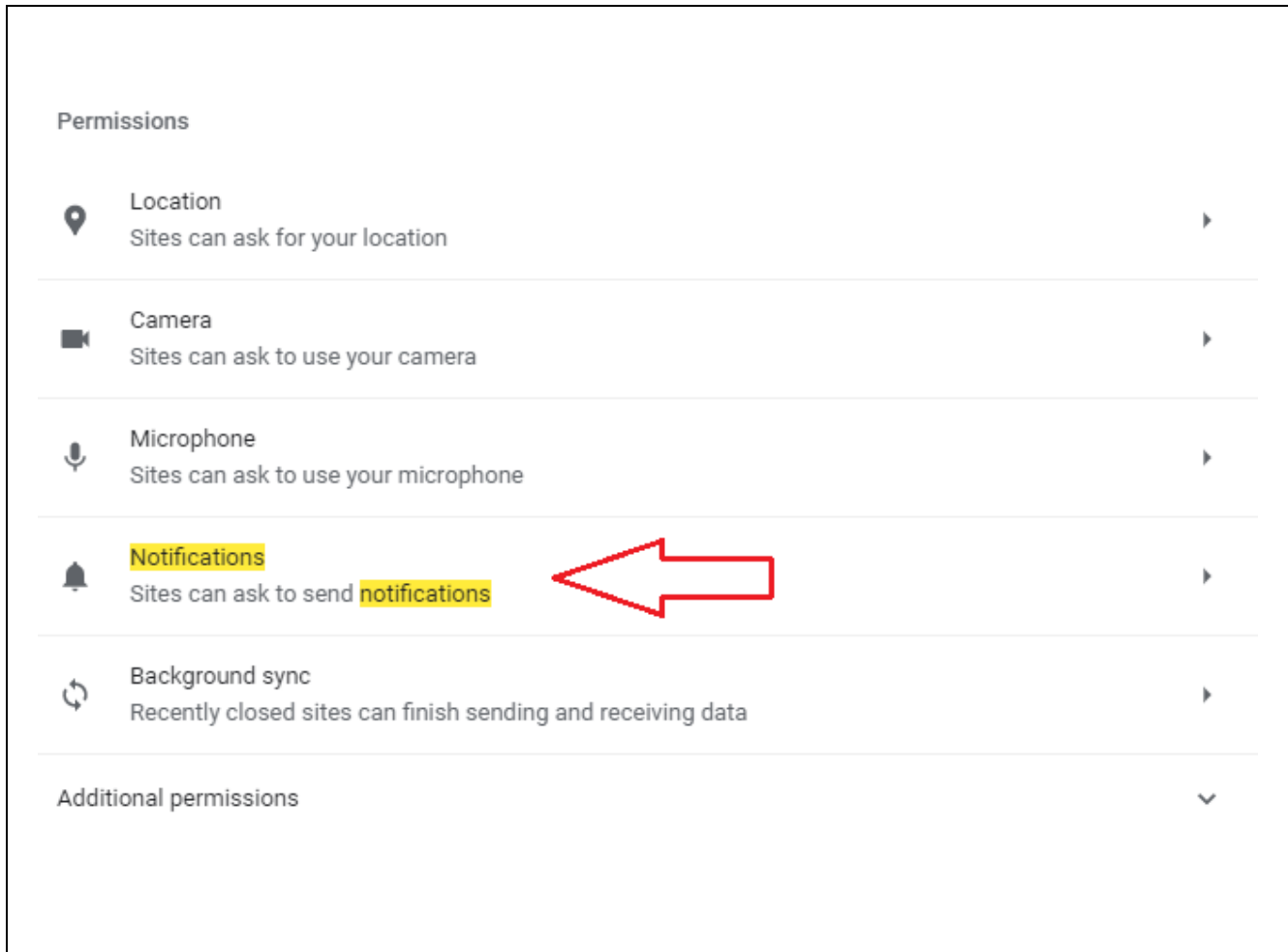
