



KINDERGARTEN 2021-2022

Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year begins
Monday, April 19.

Spring enrollment helps ensure classrooms are properly staffed in the fall.

Students must be 5 years old as of midnight, August 31, 2021.

Where to Enroll for Kindergarten

Students should register at their neighborhood school, according to the district attendance boundaries. If you need assistance determining your school, call the District Office at (360) 538-2000.

Enrollment begins online. Here's what you'll need to get started:

- Proof of age, such as a birth certificate or passport
- Immunization Records
- Emergency Contact Information
- Proof of Address such as identification, or an energy or utility bill with your current address (not a P.O. Box), lease agreement or mortgage statement

Requesting a Different School

If you want your student to attend a different school you may request a transfer when you register. Requests are granted based on available space and sufficient program capacity.

Transfer Requests are dated, time-stamped and honored using the following criteria:

1. Students with a parent or legal guardian who works in the building are automatically accepted.
2. Next priority is given to students with an enrolled sibling at the requested school.
3. Next priority is given to parents with daycare considerations.
4. Should space remain, next priority is given to remaining requests.

PLEASE NOTE: The District will place as many students as possible prior to the end of the current school year. Remaining requests will be addressed not later than the third day of school. Requests must be renewed each year and ongoing placement cannot be guaranteed.

Choice Requests: Procedure for Out-of-District (Non-Resident) Students

The District will begin accepting 2021-2022 Choice requests for non-resident kindergarten students on **Monday, April 19**. The form is available online and must be returned to Dee Anne Shaw in the Superintendent's Office, 216 North G St., dshaw@asd5.org.

Students of employees are automatically approved. All remaining applications will be considered in August after the in-district students are placed. Students cannot be enrolled until a decision has been made on whether there is sufficient classroom space and program capacity.

If a school or program is full, you will be notified prior to the start of the school year. Otherwise, placement of non-resident kindergarten students will be made as soon as possible but not later than the third day of school.

Choice requests must be renewed each year and ongoing placement cannot be guaranteed.
