

What is World Class Scholar?

The World Class Scholar (WCS) program started in 1993 to form a **partnership between students, parents, and Grays Harbor College**. This partnership brings the promise of a college education to families throughout Grays Harbor and Pacific Counties.

Students are invited to sign a contract in (beginning in the seventh grade, but no later than ninth) committing to several scholastic, leadership and community service goals to be met before their high school graduation. **What do you get for your work?** Grays Harbor College offers the commitment of entrance to GHC along with a **scholarship award** (currently at **\$2,000**) from the GHC Foundation to each World Class Scholar.

Steps To Receive Your Scholarship & World Class Scholar Award:

- Complete at least 50 community service hours.
- Complete a portfolio of materials annually documenting volunteer community service, activities, goals, and a year-end evaluation—7th – 12th grades. (Sign a commitment form your first year.)
- Demonstrate a variety of interpersonal skills, including working with groups, leadership roles and respecting others.
- Graduate from high school with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.
