3. GHC Transmittal Form (attached)—complete student/top portion) and:
  - Attachments:
    - A complete GHC Admission Application or,
    - Check here if you completed one online @ [www.ghc.edu](http://www.ghc.edu))
      - Complete one even if you plan to attend a different college
        - Not running start students—they have already done this
      - If you plan to attend GHC then you should also schedule a GHC College Placement Test (new student only, not running start students)
    - A copy of your transcript verifying that you will graduate with the required 3.0 GPA (you may request this from the AHS Registrar in the counseling center)—open copy not sealed

**Please turn in the required pages at the WCS box in the Registrar/Counseling Center at AHS (keep a copy for yourself) and email the WCS coordinator listed below that you are ready for approval of your packet.**
